The Examiner respectfully proposed: (a) to cancel the withdrawal claims 19-27, 30, 34, and 35 drawn to the non-elected species and/or invention because claim 43 apparently is not a generic claim (e.g., claim 43 is not readable upon the species of FIG. 9) and because the rejoinder of these withdrawal claims may necessitate a rejection under 35 USC 112; and (b) to resubmit a new set of FIGS. 1-17 to avoid a potential of errors during the issue and printing processes due to numerous filing of replacement drawing sets. Applicant agreed to the Examiner's proposal.
