
Remarks

These remarks are submitted in response to the Non-Final Office Action of March 4, 2015. At the time of the Office Action, claims 1-20 were pending. No new matter has been added.

I. Allowable Subject Matter

Claims 4-5 and 15 are objected to as being dependent upon a rejected base claim, but would be allowable if rewritten.

II. Double Patenting Rejection

Claims 1-3, 6-14 and 16-20 are rejected on the ground of non-statutory double patenting as being unpatentable over claims 1 and 8-29 of U.S. Patent No. 8,866,691. We respectfully disagree with the assertion of the double patenting rejection. However, in order to advance prosecution, a Terminal Disclaimer attached hereto is submitted to overcome such rejection.
